G.S.R. --- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation, Directorate of Printing, Government of India Presses and Branches (Group 'C' and 'D' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2003, in so far as it relates to the post of Hindi Translator, except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Hindi Translator in the Government of India Presses and Branches under the Directorate of Printing, Ministry of Urban Development, namely:-

(1) Short Title and Commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development, Directorate of Printing, Government of India Presses and Branches, Junior Translator Group 'B', Recruitment Rules, 2015.

(2). They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(2) Number of posts, classification and pay band, grade pay and pay scale. – The number of said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

(3) Method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule

(4) Disqualification. - No person ;

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the posts under these Rules:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other legal grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

(5) Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons for recruitment under these Rules.

(6) Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

G.S.R. --- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of "the Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation, Directorate of Printing, Government of India Presses and Branches (Group 'C' and Group 'D' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2003", in so far as it relates to the posts of Stenographer Grade 'C' and Nurse, except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Stenographer Grade-I and Nurse in the Government of India Presses and Branches under the Directorate of Printing, Ministry of Urban Development, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement. -- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development, Directorate of Printing, Government of India Presses and Branches, Stenographer Grade-I and Nurse Recruitment Rules, 2015.

(2) These rules shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. -- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of Posts, classification and pay band, grade pay or pay scale. -- The number of said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification. - No person –

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to the posts under these Rules:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is Permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other legal grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, if may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons for recruitment under these Rules.

7. Saving. – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedules Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
